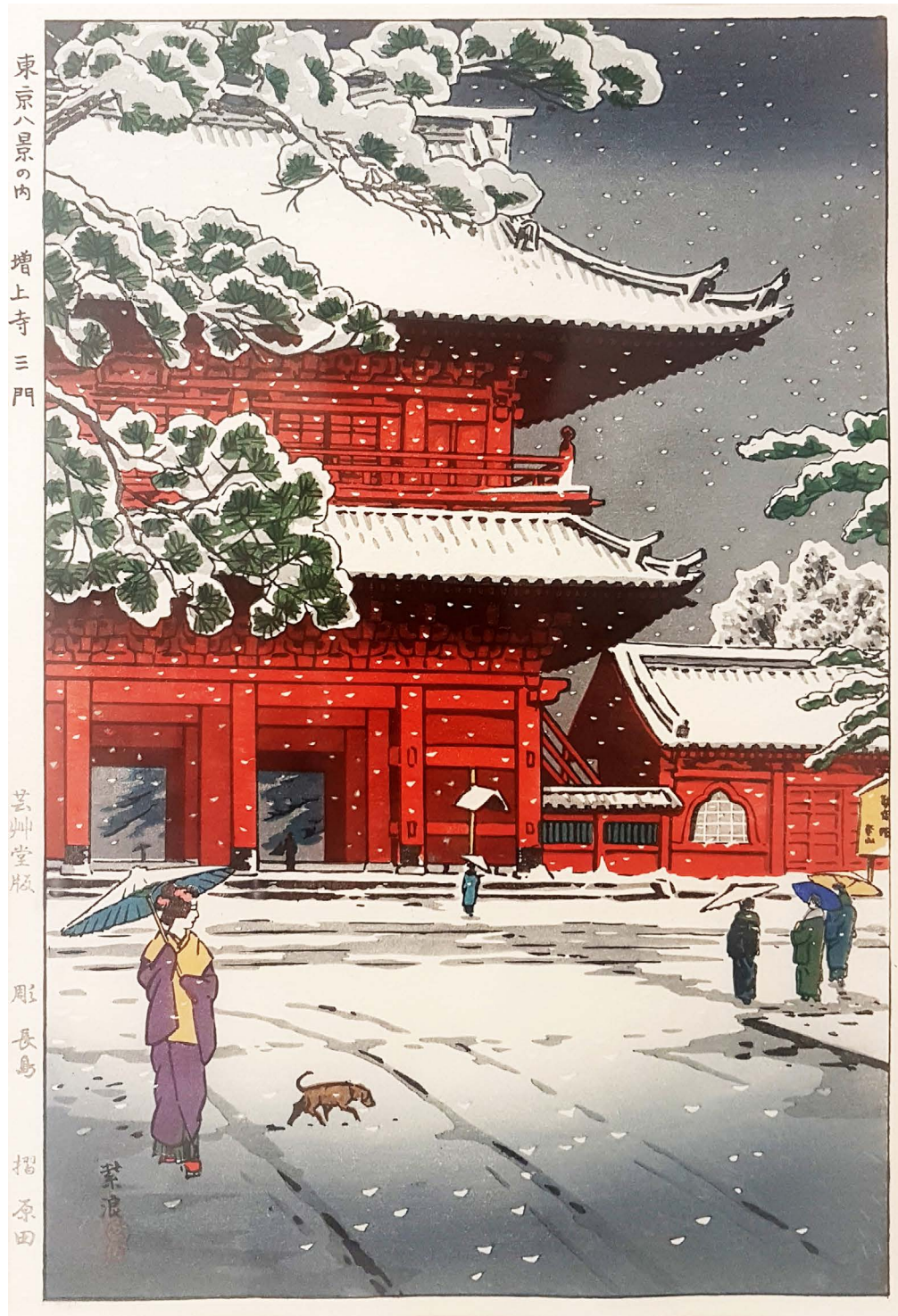

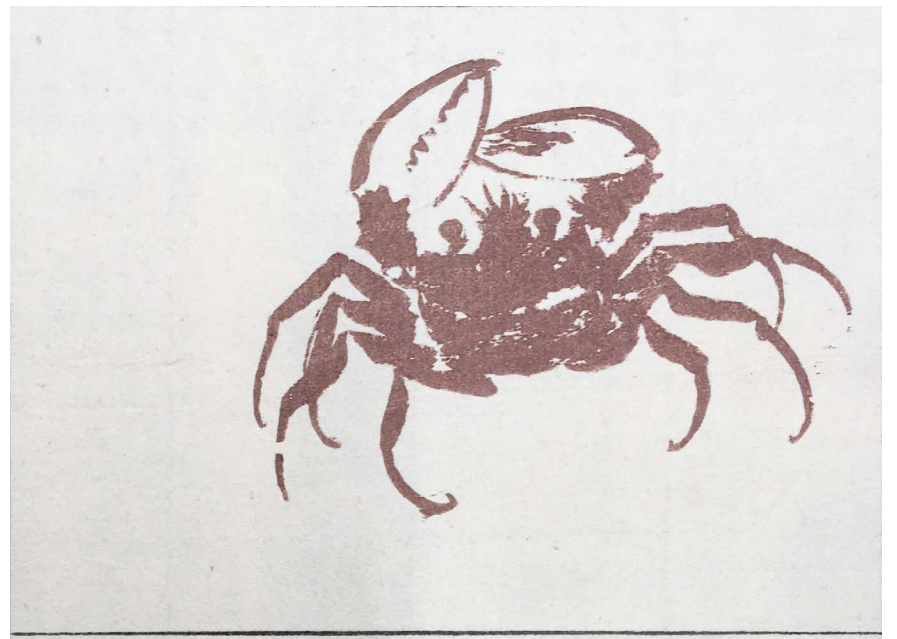

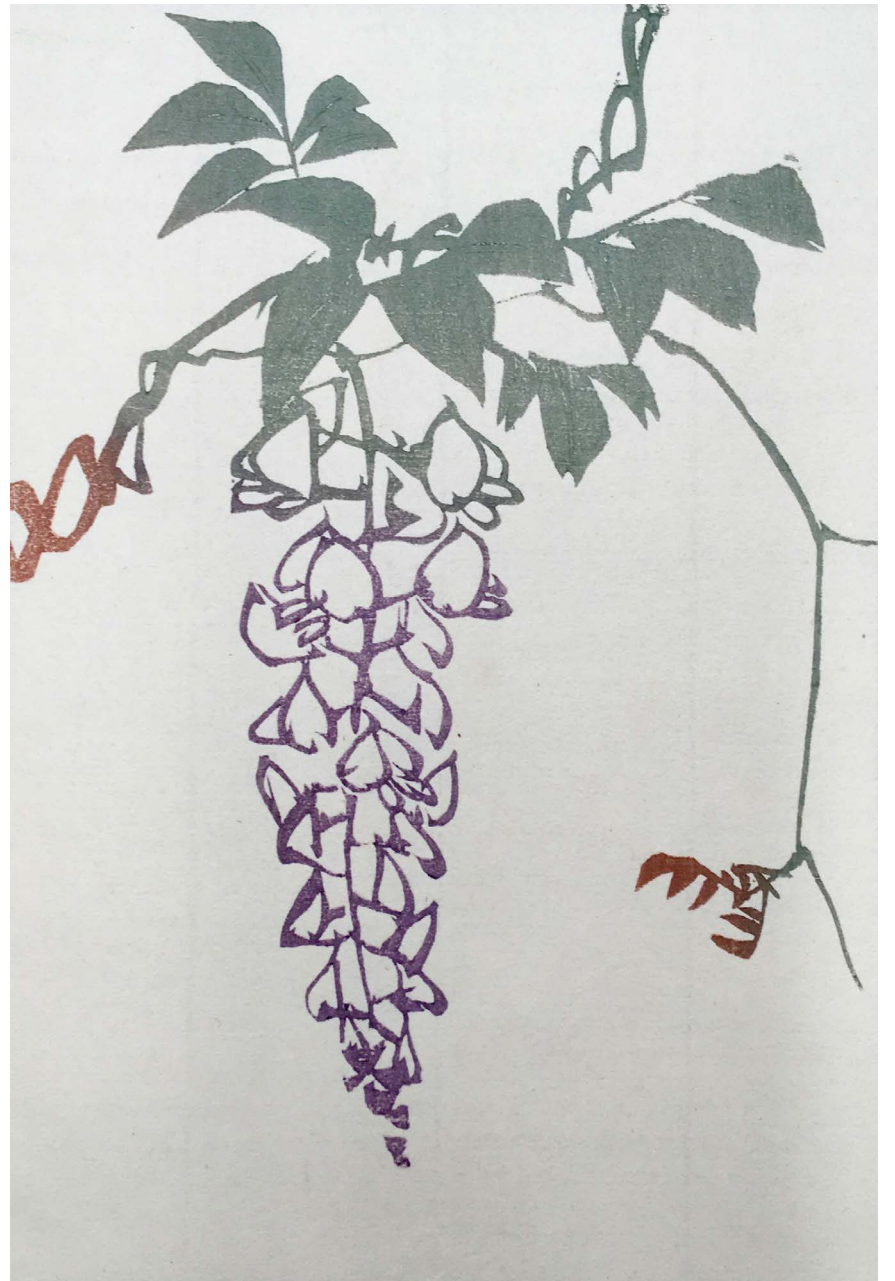

Please note: Where a work is labelled 'reprint', the piece has been reproduced by other artists, engravers, and printers several decades later, usually in the late 19th or early 20th century during a revival of the method, based on the original design or even using the original blocks. These are not recent digital reproductions, and usually carry considerable value in their own right. They can occasionally use different colours or patterns to distinguish them from the original and show off the skills of the new artisans involved. These represent more affordable and accessible ways to collect woodblock prints in cases where the rare originals can be worth thousands of pounds (or more)!
